## **Recommendations for Transition to eCHAM**

As communicated in a November 20, 2014 letter to Tribal Health Directors (click to view), the 2006 Alaska Community Health Aide/Practitioner Manual (CHAM) will not be supported effective 1/1/2015. At this time, the electronic Alaska Community Health Aide/Manual (eCHAM) should be used by every Community Health Aide/Practitioner (CHA/P) and referral provider. The following is a set of recommendations to consider as we transition to the eCHAM.

- 1. All CHA/Ps, referral providers, and other staff who interact clinically with CHA/Ps need to have access to the eCHAM.

- 5. We are preparing the PDF for printing and it will be available soon. The eCHAM with all four books as well as the eCHAM Emergency Field Handbook by itself will be available for purchase in print form.
- 6. The iCHAM app has been updated to work offline. This new version will be available as soon as the approval process at the Apple App Store is complete. Another version of the iCHAM will be available late winter/early spring 2015 to resolve issues experienced with the personalization features of the iCHAM.
- 7. Each THO should establish guidelines for training and content updates.

- 8. Each THO should have plans/budgets for the replacement of equipment needed for access to the eCHAM/iCHAM.

- Standing Orders and exams have been updated with minor content changes based on eCHAM revisions. It is recommended that all CHA/Ps with Standing Orders retake their Standing Orders exams to demonstrate that they can navigate the eCHAM.
