(a) Approved Continuing Education Topics

- 1. All continuing education courses must be no less than 1 hour in length
- 2. At least 10 hours of the subject matters must be listed in the education section of one of the DHA levels in Chapter D-2 Standard for Dental Health Aides.
- 3. All other hours must be related to the practice of dentistry.
